For residents of the City of Hume and Moreland. Must have a valid Health Care Card, Pension Card or Asylum Seeker/Refugee ImmiCard.

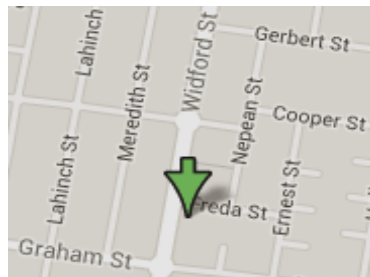
